

Even though it seems so much longer ago than it was, I recall picking up this odd and compelling CD called "You Love Chinese Food" by Pablos Eye on the Australian label Extreme, who's claim to fame at that point was putting out some of the more choice Muslimgauze albums. I was surprised and excited by what I heard. I have a really hard time describing their music and that's to their credit. I can say that it was maybe one of the most successful marriages of organic and synthetic sounds at the time. Even now it sounds so fresh. Their sampling techniques are especially mind boggling when you consider what year it was. Spoken word, sound collage, guitar work, and synth, all woven together with such precision and skill.

Even though the original album "You Love..." is our of print, thanks to the Belgian label **STROOM** you can get 3 albums worth of their stuff. I think the "Spring Break" compilation is a great place to start. I hope that I helped someone find one of their new favorite records. The history of 90s music is being rewritten by the youngsters out there, they know Pablo's Eye was top of the heap. Do yourself a favor and check it out.
